SECTION II – PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- 4. <u>Purpose and intent of the grant</u>: We are proposing the use of grant monies to continue to support a safe school campus, to help the community recognize where are front office is, to enhance outdoor activities for students, improve school beautification, and provide funding for students to attend field trips which will enhance their school experience. Grant monies will support our school efforts to attract and retain families with children so they will decide to keep their children at our school in the local community of Sunland.
 - A. SLATS FENCING PROJECT: We are proposing to purchase and install fence slats that will provide privacy and protection for our kindergarten yard. The purpose of the slats will help our outside kindergarten area to be more private and protected in case of neighborhood crisis situations, police activity, and situations where our very young children should not be witness to.
 - B. SUNLAND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FRONT OFFICE SIGN: Our school main office is not located at the very front of the school and therefore, parents and community members are often confused on where to find the main office. We are proposing to establish a Main Office sign that will be attractive and easy to see to help parents and community members locate our main office.
 - C. SCHOOL BEAUTIFICATION: We are proposing to purchase district approved trees and plants to enhance the beautification of the school campus and to provide additional shade for students and staff during the hot summer months.
 - D. OUTSIDE PLAYGROUND GAMES & ACTIVITIES: We are proposing to purchase outdoor playground games that can provide students with additional opportunities to enjoy recess and designated break times through structured and fun outdoor games and activities. A variety of games and outdoor activities will encourage students to socialize and learn how to follow rules and be good sports during competitive activities.

E. FIELD TRIP OPPORTUNITIES: To enhance the educational experience of our students, we propose to utilize grant monies to help fund additional field trip experiences for our students. Grant monies could be used for costs of school buses and various fees of designated and approved field trip locations.

5. How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large?

We at Sunland Elementary feel strongly that our school is indeed at the "Heart of the Community". Sunland Elementary has a strong connection to the Sunland community as we share a history and ongoing connection to Sunland. By supporting our efforts at Sunland Elementary School, we will be able to continue our school's vision of serving the children and families of our school community and to entice families to continue sending their children to our school instead of considering private and/or charter schools. We want to make our school as attractive and enticing as possible to continue the tradition of a strong community and school connection which will ultimately serve the public and benefit the Sunland community.

SECTION III – PROJECT BUDGET OUTLINE

- A. SLATS FENCING PROJECT EXPENSES: \$1000.00 to purchase and install fencing to cover all sides of the kindergarten yard.
- B. SUNLAND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FRONT OFFICE SIGN: \$1,500.00 to purchase materials and pay fees of installation of sign.
- C. SCHOOL BEAUTIFICAITON: \$500.00 to purchase trees, plants, and shrubs to enhance our school beautification project.
- D. OUTDOOR PLAYGROUND GAMES & ACTIVITIES: \$2,000.00 to purchase outdoor games and activities for students. Games & activities to be used during recess, break times, and school events.
- E. FIELD TRIP OPPORTUNITIES: \$6,000.00 to fund school busses and field trip fees for all students Preschool through 5th grade.

TOTAL AMOUNT OF GRANT FUNDING REQUESTED: \$11,000.00
