

The Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council (STNC) Land Use Committee (LUC) met on July 18, 2022 with Armen Grikorian who is owner/CEO of Forever Young, which is in the process of getting licensed as a Community Based Adult Services (CBAS) business.

During the Land Use Committee meeting, the applicant presented background and answered questions from committee members and the public on his project. The following summarizes the presentation and testimony that was relayed by the applicant regarding the project proposal during the presentation.

- Forever Young will be a licensed Adult Day Care facility and Community-Based Adult Services (CBAS) organization
- Services will include: Professional nursing services, therapies, therapeutic activities, mental health services, and social services.
- Due to the size of the building, applicant meets the licensing requirement for a maximum of 216 participants. Mr. Grikorian stated he does not anticipate they will reach capacity on a day-to-day basis, although no explanation was submitted.
- Forever Young would not solicit participants but be entirely serving members who were referred to them by Medicare and/or Medi-Cal.
- The hours of operation for the adult daycare will be 8:00 am to 1:00 pm Monday thru Friday. On Saturday and Sunday, and some weekends, the property may be used by The Hub Church for church services.
- Staff parking and participant drop off and pick up will take place only in the rear of the building
  where the larger parking lot is located. Transportation for participants will be provided to and
  from the participant's residence by the facility. Vans will deliver clients by travelling through the
  east side of the building to the rear and pull up to the center of the now fenced-in unit to enter
  the facility. This area will be ADA compliant. Applicant has no plans to disrupt the retail
  orientation of the rest of the property.
- The number of staff members required by the Health Department depends on the number of participants per day.

During discussion, the applicant testified that a website was developed for the proposed business and tenant improvements were already made to the interior of the structure prior to submittal of conditional use application, in preparation for the new adult day care use.





## Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council

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No signage plans were presented. Mr. Grikorian stated that he intended to have curtains covering the front windows from the inside. The Committee discussed with Mr. Grikorian of the need for signage permits, including maximum signage restrictions on windows.

The Committee discussed with Mr. Grikorian that the planning application requires the applicant to list all of the addresses of all the businesses in the complex however, the only addresses listed are: 8263; 8265 and 8267. The primary address is listed 8265.

Stakeholders attending this meeting expressed disappointment that the current retail use would end as there was a stated preference for more retail activity in the area.

This land has been in constant and exclusive use by 10320 N Samoa for many years. It has been fenced for over 30 years. 



We, the Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council board members, support the Golden Hills Retirement Center's request for a CCE grant to improve their facilities and provide much-needed access to long-term care for seniors that are completely dependent on Social Security income. With specialized funding from the grant the Center can provide renovations to their facility and commit more beds to Sunland-Tujunga's vulnerable SSI seniors.

The state of California has recently determined LA County is not meeting the needs of its most vulnerable residents. As a part of the City of Los Angeles, with housing and cost of living being among the highest in the nation, Sunland-Tujunga seniors who have a limited income are at a higher risk of experiencing homelessness than in many other cities. The CCE grant would allow Golden Hills to be a vital safeguard against housing insecurity for SSI residents for the next twenty years.

The Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council is in favor of CF 22-0798 Responsible Beverage Service Training Program (RBSTP) / Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) / AB 1221 / Alcohol Servers / Online and In-Person Training / Business Source Centers. We feek that ensuring up to date training for alcohol servers is beneficial to our community.

The Sunland-Tujunga Neighborhood Council is in favor of CF 22-0002-S101, AB 1740 (Muratsuchi) / AB 2407 (ODonnell) / SB 1087 (Gonzalez) / Used Catalytic Converter Sales: Introduced on July 14, 2022 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles includes in its 2021-2022 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 1740, AB 2407 and SB 1087, which would seek to strengthen the laws governing the sale of used catalytic converters, thereby assisting law enforcement in reducing thefts and discouraging the commission of the crime.

While this does not eliminate the problem of the theft and sale of catalytic converters, it is a step in the right direction to reducing the theft of catalytic converters.

Sunland and Tujunga, the "Place of the Old Woman", of the beautiful unceded land of the Tongva, once again commits to reaffirming Indigenous Peoples, their culture, contributions, relationship to the land, and visionary leadership. This cultural, educational, and community-centered celebration will be organized and shaped by the following key values: respect for the land, reciprocity, relational educational opportunities, cultural diversity, and generative dialogue.

Specific planned expenditures of grant funds would include facility and rentals costs.

5) How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large. (Grants cannot be used as rewards or prizes for individuals)

The grant would allow for the public to learn from and interact with indigenous artists, educators, performers, and cultural leaders. In addition, the public will have access to vendors, service organizations, non-profits, and educational booths that are curated to uplift the work of cultural practitioners and organizations who are Indigenous and/or serve Indigenous communities. A preliminary list of partnering artists and organizations includes: Alan Salazar (Tatavlam artist), Lazaro Arvizu (Tongva artist & educator), Kuruvungna Spring Foundation, Sherman Indian School Riverside, CA Native Vote Project, Ti'at Society, the CSULB Drum Collective, and Indigenous Circle of Wellness.

As with our inaugural Indigenous Peoples' Day event, this 2nd Annual IPD event will be free and open to the public, with free on-site parking -- golf carts will transport the elderly and disabled directly to the event. We are partnering with the Verdugo Hills Archers to provide free overflow parking adjacent to the event site.


